| Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis (FVR) | Upper respiratory infection Highly contagious | | | | | | | | |
| Calicivirus (C) | Upper respiratory infection Highly contagious | | | | | | | | |
| Feline Panleukopenia (P) | Highly contagious High mortality rate in kittens Also known as "feline enteritis" | | | | | | | | |
| Rabies | Fatal viral infection of the nervous system. Booster annually or triennially based on product. State laws vary. | | | | | | | | |
| Non-Core Vaccines: Recommended on individual need. Partial list. Consult with veterinarian for other non-core vaccines. | | | | | | | | | |
| Feline Leukemia | Attacks immune system Highly contagious Can be transmitted in utero or to nursing kittens Recommended only for kittens at risk | | | | | | | | |
| Feline Immuno-Deficiency Virus (FIV) | Weakens immune system Vaccine interferes with FIV test Only for cats at high risk | | | | | | | | |
| Feline Infectious Peritonitis (FIP) | Two forms: wet or dry Highly fatal "Feline coronavirus" Controversial vaccine; not recommended | | | | | | | | |
