## Wand Toy

### Supplies:

- 1 old sweatshirt or T-shirt
- 1 chopstick or old ruler
- 1 thick rubber band, like the kind on veggies at the grocery store
- Scissors

Take the old sweatshirt or T-shirt and cut 1-inch wide strips. Tie the pieces together with double knots until you have about 48-60 inches of fabric "string." Tie a knot on one end to give your cat something to grab on to. Tie the other end of the "string" around the rubber band, then wrap the rubber band around the end of the chopstick or ruler until it's secure. You now have a homemade wand toy you can dangle for your kitty. Get ready for her to leap and play!
