**American Wirehair:** The American Wirehair sports an exceptional coat, as each hair is bent or hooked, producing a dense, springy coat, with whiskers of the same texture. American Wirehair was developed from the American Shorthair, so apart from the coat, the two display many similarities. From barn to show arenas, these rough-coated felines will hook your fancy. **Cornish Rex:** The Cornish Rex is known for its soft, wavy curls--even the whiskers curl. **LaPerm:** The LaPerm is an exceptional combination of curly hair and affection. This longhair breed often wears a curly, plumed tail and exhibits a full, curly ruff.
