Dogs and cats in Cheyenne, Wyo., might soon be required to get a rabies shot only every three years instead of the annual shot that's currently required. Pet owners would still need to get a current rabies tag from a veterinarian, serving as proof of immunization and annual registration, the Associated Press reports.
