Do you love to quilt? Or is embroidery your hobby of choice? No matter which craft captures your fancy, Cat Designs: Patterns for Craftspeople and Artisans provides the patterns you need to make beautiful artwork. Each pattern design features a cat conveying the attitude that cat lovers cherish in their pets. The patterns translate well to many crafts, such as applique, card making, embroidery, glass, mosaics, quilting, silk or china painting and stained glass.

Crafters can choose from familiar feline expressions such as Where's My Dinner? or Why Did You Stop Scratching Me? Each pattern contains between 11 and 30 pieces that appeal equally to beginning crafters and advanced artisans who want to construct a dramatic project.

Illustrated examples throughout the book are geared mainly toward stained glass artisans, but each pattern is accompanied by a color guide that helps crafters apply the pattern to other craft mediums. Line drawings also accompany each design, as well as technical tips for executing the designs.
