

## Homeward Bound Hosts PETopoly Fundraiser

"We will donate a portion of our net proceeds of this event to another local animal welfare organization that will be announced at the event that evening," said Carol Fox, Homeward Bound co-founder and president. "We hope this event will generate community awareness for this important cause that affects all pet lovers."
