Many of those animals have found loving homes in the United States, but several are still searching for that perfect family match.

The adoption event will be held Friday, Jan. 26, from noon to 7 p.m.; Saturday, Jan. 27, from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.; and Sunday, Jan. 28, from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. All pets are spayed or neutered and have received microchip identification and vaccinations. Adoption fees are \$95 for dogs and \$65 for cats, with adoption fees waived for the second animal if two pets are adopted by the same family.
