

Animal Protection Society Discounts Cat Adoptions

Sale aims to cut down the number of cats at the shelter.

Faced with an overrun of homeless cats and kittens, the Churchill Animal Protection Society (CAPS) in Churchill County, Nev., is holding a cat adoption sale.

An already spayed/neutered kitten with current shots is normally \$100; that price is being cut to \$60. An already spayed/neutered adult cat with current shots is usually \$80; that price is now \$40.

The nonprofit, no-kill shelter's sale will continue until the shelter is "at a comfortable level in our cattery," according to Jennifer Williamson, shelter president. The shelter still will utilize its current potential adopter screening process, according to Williamson.

The shelter also has a \$10 voucher program called CAPS SNAPs (Spay and Neuter Assistance Program) for spaying/neutering pets. To qualify, applicants must make less than \$25,000 per year and live in Churchill County.
